## April - May 2019

**Literacy** – This term we will be learning all about space and we will begin by writing facts about the Moon. We will also be reading lots of space and alien themed books and we will be writing retells, letters, character descriptions and diary entries based on these stories.

**Numeracy** - this term we will be revising: 1 and 10 more, 1 and 10 less, money, doubles, addition and subtraction, time and fractions. We will also be learning: how to add three small numbers, capacity and weight, entering data and presenting it on a block graph and we will also be working on halving numbers.

**Science** – this term we will be learning about plants.

**ICT**– The children will be using Purple Mash software to create their own astronaut and they will be creating their very own postcard from space.

**History** – We will be learning about Neil Armstrong and the first Moon landing. We will also be learning about Christopher Columbus and will be comparing their missions.

**PE**– our topic this term is Team Games and we will continue our sports coaching with Dan.

**Art and Design** - the children will be creating tree paintings and planet themed art. **RE** - the children will be learning about Shabbat.
