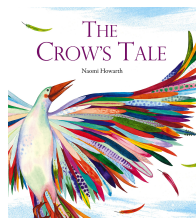
FINAL Summer Term

Welcome back!

I hope you all enjoyed the Platinum Jubilee celebrations last weekend and are ready to complete your FINAL term in the infants! This term is shaping up to be our busiest one yet with plenty to look forward to including: Arts Week, Sports Day and our summer trip to Muncaster Castle! Take a look at what we will be learning about over the next six weeks:

English

In English we will be exploring the message behind the story of 'The Crow's Tale' by Naomi Haworth. The book explores the themes of diversity, bravery and courage. We will use text maps to learn parts of the story and discover what is needed to write a character and setting description. Children will also revise key grammar terms including conjunctions, commands and exclamations as well as the spelling rules needed to add suffixes onto root words accurately.



Maths

This term we will be learning how information can be presented in a variety of different ways including block charts and pictograms. Children will explore how different types of information can be collected and presented and also how to use the data to answer questions. Finally, we will finish the term with some practical maths involving how to measure mass, volume and length.

PE

PE will take place every **TUESDAY** and **FRIDAY**. We will be developing our teamwork and communication skills as well as learning how to build up our core strength. On Fridays, our coach Dan, will be teaching the skills of athletics, which include running, jumping and throwing.



Geography

For our final History topic we will be learning about our local landmark, Egremont Castle! Why was it built here? When was it built? Who could've built it? What would it have looked like? Who might have lived inside? Are all questions we hope to find out as we delve into its past!
