Literacy

In English, we will be exploring “The Lighthouse Keeper’s Lunch”. The children will begin this topic by creating actions for the class story map. Then the children will create their own story maps, they may even innovate the story by changing the setting or a character. We will also explore the story mountain by discussing what happens at various points in the story. In phonics, the children will be working on Phase 4 and consolidating Phase 3 learning.

Maths

In Maths, we will continue to consolidate our key skills of subitising, counting, composition, sorting, matching, comparing and ordering.

Understanding of the World

R.E Key Question- What makes places special ?

The children will be exploring places that are special in different Religions. They will begin this topic by talking about their own homes. They will then explore significant buildings in different Faiths such as “The Church”, “Synagogue” and “The Mosque”.

Physical Development

Our P.E sessions this half term will take place on **Fridays**. Dan will work with the children; they will be working on fundamentals/ targets. The children will also explore their planned activities for sports day.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Jigsaw theme- Changing me – Naming parts of the body, knowing what foods are healthy, understanding that we grow from babies to adults, expressing feelings about moving to Year 1, talking about worries and sharing best bits of the Reception year.

Expressive Arts and Design

The children will be using creative skills that they have learnt across the year to create their own models, painting, pictures, collages, models etc. They will also take part in our final “Draw a person”. Charanga Songs: Reflect, Rewind & Replay Listen and appraise. Play instruments within the song. Improvisation using voices and instruments. Riff-based composition

Children will Share and perform the learning that has taken place.
