

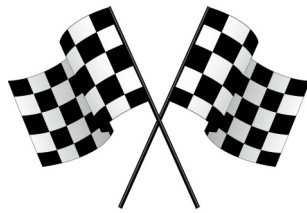

Lisa is putting away the pencils. Each packet holds 10 pencils. Lisa has 86 pencils to put away. How many packets will she need?

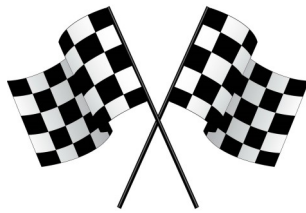
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
