Welcome back to the final half term of year 2!

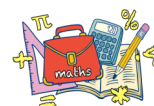

English

This half term we will be linking our learning in science to write instructions about plants, Working together, we will explain how to plant seeds and look after them. Before applying what we have learnt to write our own instructions on how to make a plant person. Later, we will write biographies using the facts we found during our research topic in computing. We will continue to revise grammar and spelling rules learnt throughout.

Maths

In our final term we will be learning how to make estimations to check our answers to problems, recognise the different relationships between $+$ $-$ \times \div and using number facts to solve problems. We will also revisit areas that we have found more challenging to get a better understanding and gain more confidence in preparation for the juniors.



Science

This term we will be learning about different types of plants, what they need to survive and how they grow. As well as making predictions and setting up experiments to find out if plants can grow in different environments. We will also be getting our hands dirty by growing our very own plants in class to watch and record what happens each week.
