## June - July 2018

**Literacy**— This term the theme for our writing will be 'Under the Sea'. We will be reading books with an under the sea theme and the children will be writing letters, diaries, character profiles, recounts and instructions for how to make a jellyfish.

**Numeracy**— this term we will be revising a lot of the work from the rest of the year, such as : 1 and 10 more, 1 and 10 less, money, doubles, addition and subtraction, time and fractions.

**Science** — this term the children will be continuing their work on plants and they will be taking part in practical science activities in our school forest area.

**ICT**—We will be creating a Photo Story.  
**Geography** - The children will be learning about the seaside.

**PE**—our topic this term is Athletics and we will continue our sports coaching with Dan.

**RE**— The children will be answering the question: Does celebrating Chanukah make Jewish children feel closer to God?

**Art and Design**— the children will be creating art with their natural surroundings in our school forest area. They will also be creating clay sculptures in our forest area.
