Maths: we will be concentrating on place value in decimals, simplifying fractions, multiplying 3-digit nos, and adding/subtracting 4 digit nos.

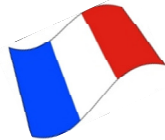
English: In our non-fiction writing we will be focussing on instructions and explanation texts. We will also be using Halloween, Bonfire Night, and Christmas to inspire our fiction work.

RE: we will be exploring the story of the very first Christmas



Science: our topic is still 'States of Matter'

French: we will be continuing to learn to talk about our pets.
