Maths Lesson 9 (Addition facts to 20 and related subtraction) that is part of the maths scheme (Effective Maths) we use in school. Your child could share a book everyday. This could be reading a book aloud everyday or sharing a book with an adult and just listening or talking about what you have read.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Read the next chapter in your to do folder on purple mash with an adult – they may need to read it to you then complete the activity based on it Find and write 5 words in your reading book - Can you add the sound buttons under these words? Record yourself reading the phoneme spotter postcard. I love seeing how your reading is improving. Phoneme Spotter on seesaw – see if you can highlight all the graphemes (letters) that make the ea sound. Read a book from oxford owl website. <p>Username: year1book password: Book1</p> |

Read Pippety's list poem (on seesaw) and solve the riddles Draw what you might find in a giant's pocket – remember they have BIG pockets and write a list poem. |

Play these [games](#) about healthy eating.

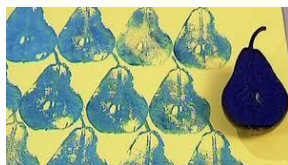
What do we have today? Look in the kitchen to see if you can create an A-Z list of foods.

Using different drawing materials, can you create a picture of your own

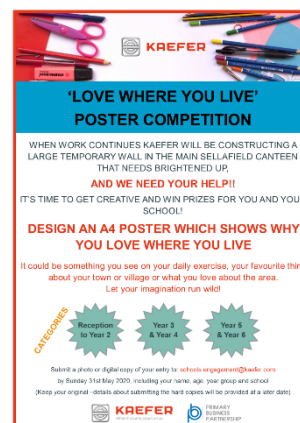


Computing
