<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Working on Times Table Rockstars (20 mins on SOUND CHECK). • Effective Maths Lesson 1 – Multiplication: x 3 numbers solving problems • Effective Maths Lesson 2 – Multiplication: using known facts • Working on Purple Mash – Friday Multiplication Test set as a 2Do • Effective Maths Quiz – Statistics: Sorting diagrams. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Working on Purple Mash read 'The Pirate Family Smith' chapter 3 and complete the quiz. • Ask your child to find the lyrics to their favourite song and highlight some creative words used, find out the meaning of new words. • Working on Read Theory – your child will have an individual login to access this. Read and complete the comprehension questions.

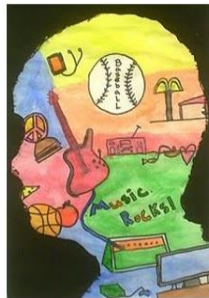
