## English

This half term we will begin by finishing our work on performance poetry and recording each group performing. After that, we will be studying persuasive writing and completing our own persuasive texts. Our grammar and punctuation focus will be on apostrophes as well as continuing to build on our skills of writing in paragraphs. One of our targets is to improve our handwriting and remembering our front joins.

## Maths

This half term we will consolidate our place value knowledge of 3 digit numbers and extend that to greater numbers. During our work on addition and subtraction, we will look at missing numbers, estimation, the column method and making the previous hundred. We will also revise our times tables work and do division of the 3, 4 and 8 times tables using partitioning.

## Science

How plants grow is our Science focus for this half term. The pupils will learn about the functions of different parts of a plant, how water is transported in a plant, pollination, seed formation and dispersal and seeds as a food source. We will be planting seeds and observing the growth of these until Easter.
