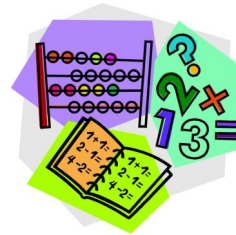
There are lots of exciting events happening this half term including our class assembly on Thursday 30th January at 9:15am.
