Weekly Maths Tasks	Weekly Reading Tasks
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Get your child to play on <a href="#">Times Table Rockstars</a> for 5 – 10 minutes a day.</li> <li>Daily <a href="#">arithmetic</a> for different areas of maths. Ask your child to work on level 4, 5 and 6 activities and try to focus on fractions.</li> <li><a href="#">Effective Maths Lesson 1</a></li> <li><a href="#">Effective Maths Lesson 2</a></li> <li><a href="#">Mathletics</a> – minimum of 300 points please. Some activities have been assigned but you can also access Live Mathletics etc.</li> <li><a href="#">Mathsquiz 1</a> on converting units of time.</li> <li><a href="#">Mathsquiz 2</a> solving problems</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ask your child to read a chapter from their home reading book or a book that they have borrowed from the library.</li> <li>Get them to summarise the chapter and to predict what might happen next.</li> <li>Access <a href="#">Audible</a> and carry on listening to a story.</li> <li>Make a video of you recommending your favourite book. You will need to show it, read a bit of it and talk enthusiastically about it.</li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Encourage your child to practise the Year 5/ 6 Common Exception Words (see list on seesaw)</li> <li>Then ask your child to choose 5 Common Exception words. They can then write a synonym, antonym, the meaning and an example of how to use the word in a sentence.</li> <li>Practise spellings on <a href="#">Spelling Shed</a> assignment.</li> <li>Complete the spelling errors activity on Seesaw.</li> </ul>	<p>This week I would like you to retell the story of Arachne – a Greek Myth. There are some examples here. The Literacy Shed one has the story too but no copying and pasting please. You can retell it as a story or use a comic strip format if you would like to draw as well.
