Learning Project WEEK 4	
Weekly Maths Tasks	Weekly Reading Tasks
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Get your child to play on <a href="#">Times Table Rockstars</a> for 5 – 10 minutes a day.</li> <li>Daily <a href="#">arithmetic</a> for different areas of maths. Ask your child to work on level 4, 5 and 6 activities and try to focus on fractions.</li> <li><a href="#">Effective Maths Lesson 1</a></li> <li><a href="#">Effective Maths Lesson 2</a></li> <li><a href="#">Mathletics</a> – minimum of 300 points please. Some activities have been assigned but you can also access Live Mathletics etc.</li> <li><a href="#">Mathsquiz</a> on division.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ask your child to read a chapter from their home reading book or a book that they have borrowed from the library. Record them doing a page of it and upload to Seesaw.</li> <li>Access <a href="#">Audible</a> and carry on listening to a story.</li> <li>Complete reading comprehension task on Seesaw.</li> <li>Design a new back cover for your book. Rewrite the blurb and add an informal and a formal quote to encourage people to read it.</li> </ul>
Weekly Spelling Tasks	Weekly Writing Task
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Encourage your child to practise the Year 5/ 6 Common Exception Words (see list on seesaw)</li> <li>Then ask your child to choose 5 Common Exception words. They can then write a synonym, antonym, the meaning and an example of how to use the word in a sentence.</li> <li>Practise spellings on <a href="#">Spelling Shed</a> assignment.</li> <li>Using the word 'help' as the root, find as many words as you can in the family e.g. helpful etc. Do a mind map with help in the middle.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Find the 'How to look after a Minotaur' activity on Seesaw. Annotate/highlight the features and save into your English folder.</li> <li>Read the Mythological Creatures file on Seesaw. Choose a favourite.</li> <li>You are going to write a 'How to' guide for your chosen creature.</li> <li>Think about: Housing, diet, exercise. It can be whacky! Remember to use Year 6 punctuation and grammar.</li> </ul>
