ENGLISH



Our first topic will theme around planet Earth, exploring issues of conservation and the dangers that animals face. Children will create fact files on endangered animals and be introduced to different sentence types.

SCIENCE



Our first topic will be 'Living Things and their Habitats'. Children will be introduced to 'MRS GREN' to recognise what is alive and what is not to identify what all living things have in common. We will also explore our local environment in search for animals and their habitats.

GEOGRAPHY



Children will explore maps and aerial photos to identify human and physical features. We will apply these skills to discover more about the capital cities of London and Nairobi in Kenya - comparing how these urban areas are similar and different.

MATHS

Children will begin the term with lots of fun and practical activities around number. We will later focus on place value, learning how numbers are represented in different ways. We will then use a variety of objects, pictures, mental strategies and reasoning skills to improve our understanding of addition and subtraction.
