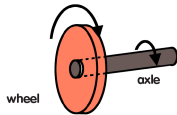
Spring 2 Term

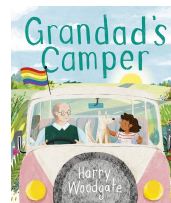
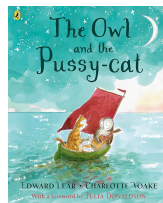
History

Maths

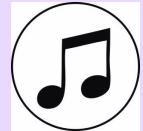
