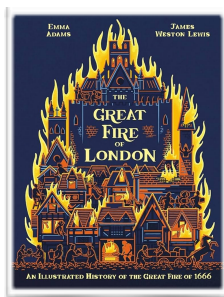
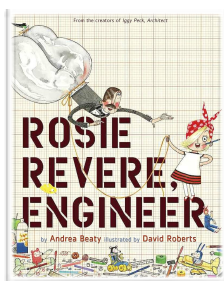
**FINAL Summer Term**

This term is shaping up to be our busiest one yet with plenty to look forward to including: rehearsals and the performance of our KS1 play 'You Are Special!', Sports Day, Arts Week and our Summer Fair! Take a quick look at what we will be learning about over the next seven weeks:

### English

In English we will be reading the brilliant book 'Rosie Revere the Engineer' by Andrea Beaty. Children will look at wacky inventions before writing guides and posters to explain how they operate. We will also read the 'The Great Fire of London' in order to write warning posters, diary entries and speeches to King Charles I. Alongside our writing we will revise key grammar terms including conjunctions, commands and exclamations as well as the spelling rules needed to add suffixes onto root words accurately.



### History

For our final History topic we will be learning about our local landmark, Egremont Castle! Why was it built here? When was it built? Who could've built it? What would it have looked like? Who might have lived inside? These are all questions we hope to find out as we delve into its past!
