Literacy

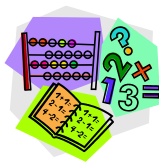
In literacy we will be writing information texts about Remembrance Day and World War 1 which will link to our history topic. We will also read about Plop's adventures in *The Owl Who Was Afraid on the Dark*. We will be doing lots of activities around this including writing our own chapters.

Numeracy

In maths we will revisit addition and subtraction and continue our work on ten more and ten less using money. We will be measuring length and practising counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.

Science

In science we will be discussing different types of food and how we can make sure we are eating healthily. We will look at how food can fall into different categories and how this can help us plan meals.



Try to read regularly at home with your child each day and complete their reading record. Reading every day really helps them become a better reader and is very important. Reading records are checked in school to ensure they are reading at home. Asking questions about what your child is reading also helps improve their understanding of what they read.
