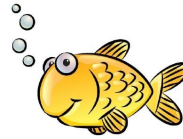


Year 2 Newsletter

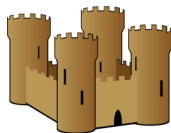

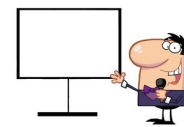


In maths we will be practising our times tables and division facts. We'll also be working on time in five minute intervals and money.
