In Maths we will be working on our multiplication skills and fractions amongst other things.

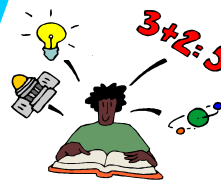
In Science we shall be learning about the Earth and our solar system.
