We will be busy!

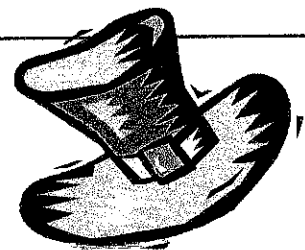

Please try and use some mathematical words when you help your child with their numbers. Words like—"more than, less than, addition, subtraction, finding the difference, sorting, biggest, smallest, tallest, shortest, first, last.

Try to encourage your child to use a number line when you are working with numbers. Playing games such as dominoes, snakes and ladders, bingo, skipping—keeping count. All these will help your child have a better understanding of numbers.
