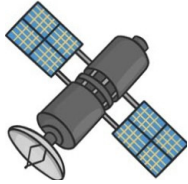


Year 1 Newsletter January 2014

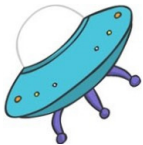


This half-term our topic is 'Space' and where possible our work in class will follow this theme.



Science - we will be looking at sources of light and investigating what we can see in total darkness. The children will learn that some objects (like the moon) are reflectors and do not actually produce light.

English - we will be sharing books with a space theme, and writing character descriptions, settings, poems and stories all about aliens and planets.



Computing - we will use our 'we are storytellers' unit to make a talking book with a space theme.



Geography - the children will learn about the Earth as a planet and learn about other planets in our solar system. History - we will learn about space travel, particularly the moon landings and find out about Neil Armstrong.



Art/DT - the children will be using different media to make aliens and planets, and design their own rockets.
