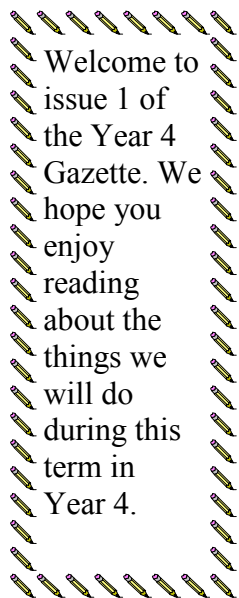


Year 4 Gazette
