In literacy, we will be studying biographies, scripts and continuing our work on persuasive texts in the form of discussion texts.

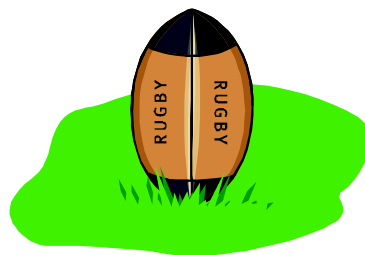
We will be extending our Magic Castle topic by looking at castles and learning about the history of Egremont castle. We will also be looking at creatures in different habitats around the castle.
