

Autumn Two in Year 1

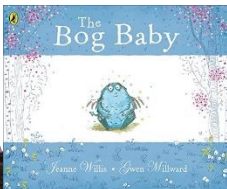
English

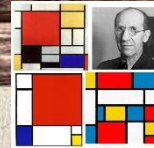
Art/DT
