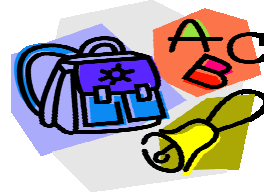


Year 3 Newsletter

Literacy

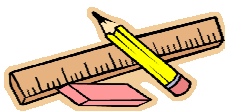
Our literacy work this term will be about mystery stories and we will be studying a novel—Ottoline and the Yellow Cat.
