Literacy

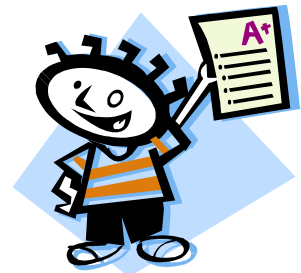
