Welcome back!

I hope you have all had a fantastic summer holiday enjoying what little of the heatwave was left and are looking forward to an exciting new year in year 2! I would like to take this opportunity to introduce myself - Miss Giles as your child's new teacher as well as Mrs Scaplehorn, as our class teaching assistant. Take a look at the exciting topics and opportunities that we will be undertaking this half term.

English

Our learning in English will be based around the picture book 'Meerkat Mail' by Emily Gravett. Using the talk for writing approach, children will internalise the story through speaking and listening activities before re-inventing it and writing a journey story of their own. We will use the text to explore new grammar including proper nouns, verbs, adjectives and adverbs as well as using commas in a list.



Science

As part of our 'Meerkat Mail' topic we will learn about animals and living things, identifying different types of animals, what they eat and how they get food. We will also discover more about animal's habitats and how they can adapt in different ways to live in certain environments as well as what animals need to survive.



Maths

This half term we will focus on place value, learning how numbers can be represented in different ways as well as ordering and comparing numbers. Later we will use a variety of objects, pictures, mental strategies, reasoning and problem solving skills to build on our understanding of addition and subtraction. We will also recap learning from year 1 to build our confidence and fluency, including counting in 2s 5s and 10s.

Geography

In Geography we will develop our knowledge of places by learning the names of the world's continents and oceans. Then about features of hot and cold environments including Antarctica and the Kalahari Desert, researching how animals are adapted to live in such places. We will also describe and compare the ways these places are similar and different to each other.
