Maths

This half term sees us concentrating on addition and subtraction to 20. Following this we will revisit coin recognition and adding and subtracting money. We will end this half term exploring place value in numbers up to 100.

Science

This half term we will be exploring plants. We will learn to name the different parts of plants. After that we will learn the difference between wild and garden plants and identifying some around school.

History/Geography

This half term we will be learning about the Great Fire of London. We will learn how London was different, what caused the fire to spread so quickly and how London changed after this significant event.

In Geography we are learning about maps. We will be creating maps for story books before mapping out real places

DT

Our topic is 'smoothies'. We will learn about fruit and vegetables and how they grow before taste testing some fruit and vegetables to help us decide what smoothie we will make. We will learn to peel and chop safely.

RE

In RE this half term we will be exploring Judaism and how they celebrate shabbat is important. They will be able to use the knowledge they gained from Simon who visited earlier this year.

Computing

Our topic this half term is called 'Maze Explorers'. Children will be involved with helping write and debug algorithms. They can explore this further at home using purple mash.
