English

This half term we will be exploring recounts and diary entries. Maths

This half term we will learn more about fractions in greater depth and the properties of shapes by calculating angles and perimeter. We will also be refining our mental maths skills to solve calculations more efficiently. By the end of year 3 children are expected to recall the 3, 4 and 8 times tables. Therefore please continue to practice these number facts at home to support their development in class.
