Literacy

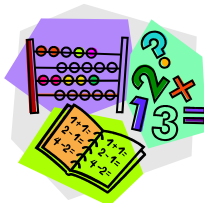
We will start by looking at and writing non-chronological reports. Then we will be learning all about Myths and Legends. We will end the term by writing our own myths.
