### Literacy

Read as often as you can and record your comments in the reading diary. Please bring it into school on Friday so that we can check you have been reading. Please practice the phonemes in the middle of the Reading Record too.

This week I would like you to write all about your summer holidays. Here are some ideas of what you could write about:

- Where did you go? Who did you go with? What did you do when you got there? What was the best thing that you did in the summer holidays?

Please try to sit your letters on the line.

### Writing

Before your child starts to write please encourage them to think about what they want to write and to then repeat their sentence out loud a few times so they can remember it. Then let your child try to write their sentence on their own and then read it back to make sure that it makes sense. At this point corrections can be made and capital letters and full stops can be discussed. Please do not write a sentence down and then get your child to copy it as the only thing they learn in this case is how to copy letters.

### Spelling

Encouraging your child to have a go, to not be afraid of making mistakes and sounding out their words is really important. After your child has completed their work you can then discuss spelling with them and get them to write out the word correctly underneath their completed work. Last year many parents said they had great success using this method as it helped their children's spelling and confidence improve.

### Clothing

Please can you make sure that your child's uniform, PE kit and PE bag are labelled with their name. Names come off easily when washed so please can you keep an eye on this as it saves children's uniform getting mixed up and time spent in class finding out whose is who. Thank you.

### Numeracy

#### Mental Maths

Please practise counting forwards from 0 to 50 and then counting backwards from 50 to 0 with your child.

If your child finds this difficult then ask them to count to and from 30 and then 40.

Likewise if your child needs challenged increase the number in multiples of 10— 60, 70, 80, 90.
