Mental maths: Please practice the following:

- You need to be able to count confidently from 1 to 20 and from 20 to 1 so please practice doing so as many times as possible this week. When confident doing so please practice counting to and from 30 and then to and from 40 and so on. (This is an ongoing target and is **extremely important** as practicing this regularly really helps support and speed up the children's numeracy work in class).
- Number bonds to 10 with your child. (We have been learning a song in class that they should be able to sing to you - "1 and 9, 1 and 9, 9 and 1, 9 and 1. That makes ten, that makes ten, 1 and 9, 9 and 1... and so on.) Here is a game they could play on to practice their number bonds:
