Number bonds to 20—Addition Circle Drills

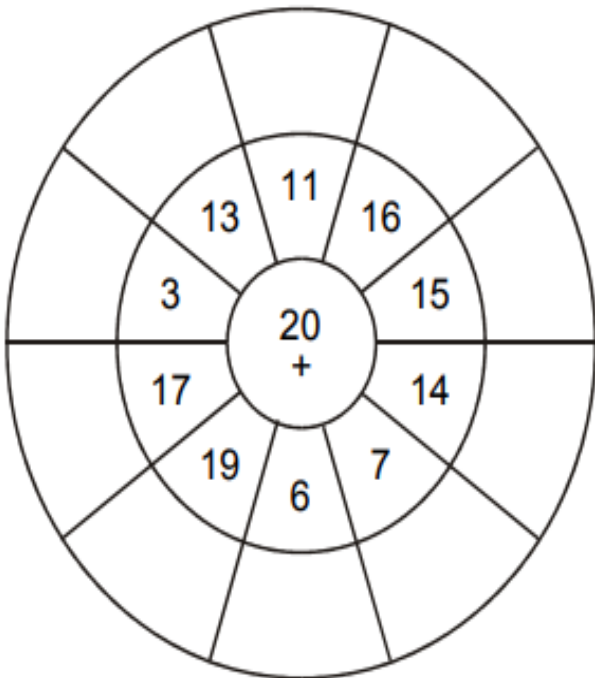
◆ Place a number in the outer circle which adds with the number in the inner circle to make the target number.

This is how I teach it in class:

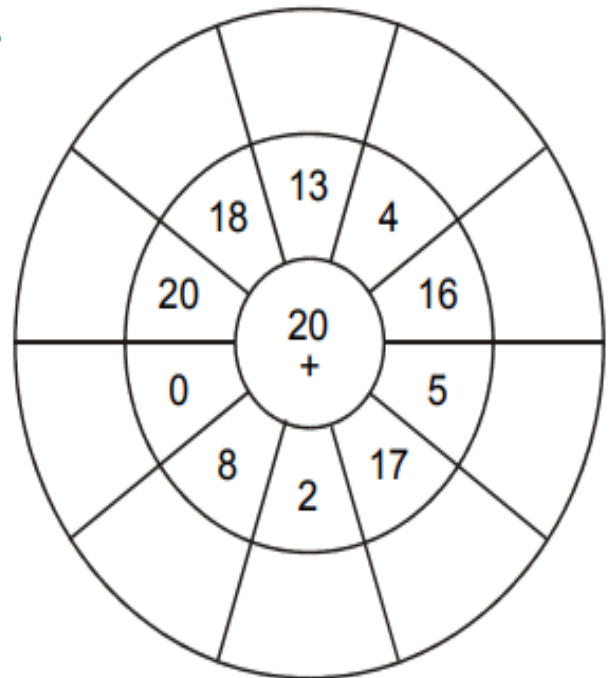
1 digit number (make a 2 digit number) - 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9 use your number bonds to 10 and then put a 1 in front of it to make a teen number.

2 digit number (make a 1 digit number): 11,12,13,14,15,16,1,18, and 19 look at the second number and then make 10. ie: 14—look at 4 and then the answer is 6 to get to the next multiple of 10.

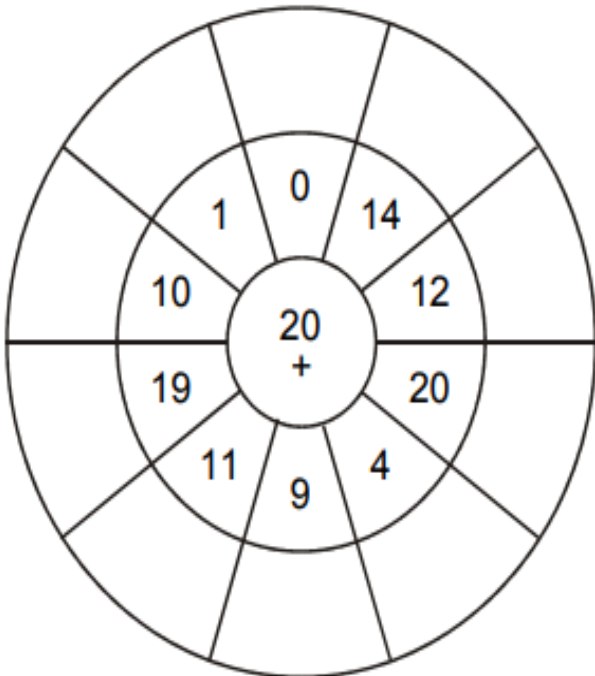
